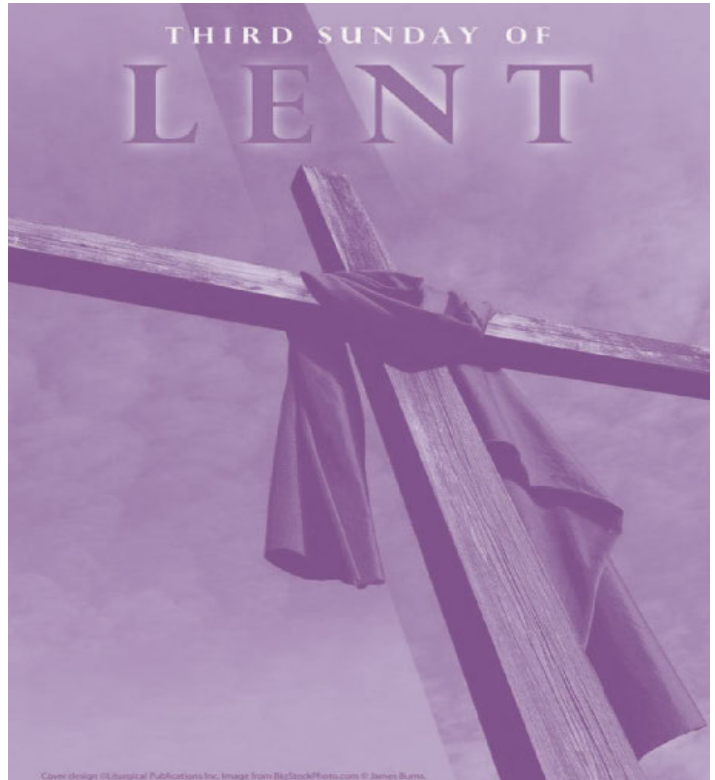

**Third Sunday of Lent**

**Spring begins!** Spring begins today, March 20th at 11:33 a.m.! I always remember the beginning of Spring because my Grandfather, Arthur Moorby, was born on the first day of Spring, March 20th, 1891! I am celebrating a Mass today for him, Friday of this week I celebrated a Mass for my father, LeRoy Moorby, on his birthday. He was born on March 18, 1920. It was easy for me growing up to remember those dates as St. Patrick's Day was the day before my dad's birthday and St. Joseph's Day was the day after his birthday and a day before my grandfather's birthday. Four straight days of celebration!

This week on Friday I celebrated with my seminary classmate, Father Joe Catanise, as he celebrated his 40th Anniversary to the Priesthood. He was ordained on March 19, 1982 on the Feast of St. Joseph. If I remember correctly he switched ordination dates with a classmate so that he could be ordained on the Feast of St. Joseph, after whom he was named. When my classmates and I were ordained each of us had a separate ordination date. We were ordained in the church where we served as Deacons the year following our graduation from St. Bernard Seminary. Father Catanise was one of the first in our class to be ordained.

I was ordained that same year at Our Lady Of Lourdes Church in Brighton, NY. on April 30th. It is hard to believe that forty years have gone by since those blessed occasions! Both of my parents were able to see me ordained; it was their 40th Wedding Anniversary the next week. My mom passed away before I celebrated my 25th Anniversary, but my dad was still alive to celebrate with me. This year as I mark my 40th Anniversary to the Priesthood, both of my parents are gone, but I know that they are with me still in the Lord, and will always remain in my heart. I thank them for helping me become the person I am today.

**CRS Rice Bowl** This year CRS Rice Bowl is focusing on three programs that are helping our neighbors in Guatemala, Bangladesh and Rwanda. Raúl and Lilian live in the village of Xequemeyá, Guatemala, with their two sons. In their village, malnutrition is high, which is especially dangerous for children. The community also struggles with water scarcity, poor education, poverty and a changing climate. Raúl and Lilian started growing tomatoes, but plant diseases and other problems destroyed their crops. Then Lilian heard about Catholic Relief Services' SEGAMIL program and how they could receive agriculture training and nutrition education for their children. Raúl and Lilian learned to manage and care for their crops. From there, they began growing for their business—adding onions, chili peppers and oranges to their crops. Produce was plentiful, but they continued to struggle—this time with selling it at markets.

Then they entered CRS' Nuestra Cosecha program that helped them register with the government to begin selling their produce to 16 local schools. Soon, they hired family and community members to harvest and pack the food. Today, they are proud to be able to help others in their community—especially children. "It helps them be stronger and to learn better ... and to avoid malnutrition in our village," Lilian says. Today, Lilian and Raul are looking forward to the future.

Together with Lilian, Raul says, "Now that I am living a dream, other dreams come. Now, my dream is to expand the business ... so other people can benefit too."

Jesus did not teach us to pray simply, "forgive us our trespasses" (trespass is another word for sin), but rather He said, "forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us." The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains that this is not because God chooses not to forgive us; rather, it is that we choose to close our hearts to His mercy because of our unwillingness to forgive (CCC 2840)

We may be unfamiliar with fig trees, but we might know about the growth of spring flowers. Perhaps we have looked at a dry, brown flower bulb and wondered how this produces the colorful tulip or daffodil blossom that we expect to bloom in the spring. Perhaps we've even thought about the patience and hope that are required to plant flower bulbs in October. We don't have to be gardeners, however, to know about patience and hopefulness. As parents, we practice these virtues each day with our children. We may become frustrated and even angered by their willfulness and lack of cooperation. Yet we continue to offer our attention and guidance in hope that one day our efforts will bear fruit. Today's parable suggests that God is like that with us, working with us in patience and in hope that one day we will show evidence that such work is not in vain. As parents, we know God's kindness when we find evidence for our hope for our children. Does God find such glimmers of hope as he works with us? Offer prayers of thanks and praise to God for his patience and hopefulness towards us. Conclude by praying together today's Psalm, Psalm 103.
